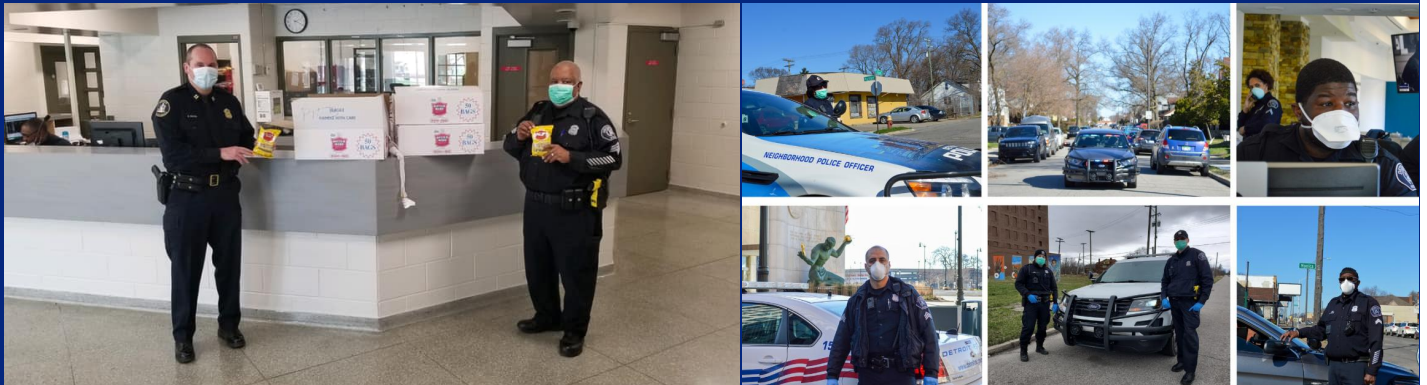

As we continue to navigate through these unprecedented times, we wanted to provide an update about the work the DPSF is doing to help keep our first-responders safe.

In response to our initial email asking for financial support for safety supplies, we were honored by the generosity and contributions from the community. The money is being used at the discretion of the Detroit Police and Fire Departments to meet their individual needs. We have purchased additional Personal Protective Equipment, no-touch thermometers, cleaning supplies, food and other needs identified by the departments.

In addition to the monetary donation, we have received incredible support through in-kind donations. We have

received approximately 3,600 donated N-95 masks, boxes of hand sanitizer, soap, gloves and cleaning supplies. We have also had meals, chips and popcorn donated for our first-responders as they work long shifts serving the citizens of Detroit.

Our partnership with the City of Detroit, Detroit Police and Fire leadership and the rank and file members is stronger than ever as we work together through this difficult time. Thanks to your generosity, we are able to continue supporting our first-responders while they focus on protecting our community.
